Balcony, Grilling, and Pet Reminders:

Balconies are NOT to be used to store items. Per the lease agreement, only patio furniture and related items are allowed on balconies and patios in the community. Please be respectful of your neighbors when using your balcony.

Regarding trash, please do not store trash on your balcony, back of trucks, on patios etc.

No grilling or open flames are allowed on balconies or patios. Propane tanks are not permitted on the property. If you wish to grill, please use our community charcoal grills located by the firepit and volleyball court. Do not leave the community grills unattended and please make sure to fully extinguish the grill when you are done!

With warm weather finally here, we just want to take a moment to remind you of the community rules regarding pets. All dogs are to be leashed at ALL times while outside, including balconies and patios. Pets are to remain under supervision at all times as well. Do not tie pets outside. These rules are for the safety and well being of all residents, pets included! Please remember to pick up after your pets. We have increased the number of dog waste stations around the community to facilitate this.
